### What to Bring to Your WIC Certification Appointment

1. Each person who is applying for WIC: \_\_\_\_\_
2. A parent, guardian or caretaker of an infant, child, or woman under 18 years old who is applying for WIC.
3. Proof of Income: Income documents for everybody in your family who works or has a source of income. For example:
  - \*Paycheck stub(s) for the past 30 days (if paid bi-weekly-bring previous 2 pay stubs), (if paid weekly- bring previous 4 paystubs), (if paid semi-monthly-bring previous 2 paystubs), or a letter from your employer stating your gross income for the past 30 days. Child support statement, Unemployment statement, Social Security statement (statements showing all gross income within the past 30 days).
  - \*You may be automatically income eligible if you or certain family members participate in the following programs: Traditional Medicaid Pkg. A, Hoosier Healthwise Pkg. B,C,E, or H; (**bring card**) or a prenatal applicant presumed eligible for Hoosier Healthwise Pkg. P, is accepted as WIC income eligible. Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), or Food Stamps **a letter of eligibility is needed.**
4. Proof of Identity  
For example:
  - \* A driver's license,
  - \* A photo ID, or
  - \* A birth certificate,
  - \* Hospital birth confirmation letter or crib card
  - \* Medicaid or Social Security card
5. Proof of Address  
For example:
  - \* A bill or business letter addressed to you,
  - \* A rent receipt, or
  - \* A current driver's license
6. \* WIC ID folder
7. \* Immunization Records
8. \* Appointment Date and Time: \_\_\_\_\_
